The Clubhouse

Welcome to Royal Montrose Golf Club, founded on 1st January 1810 as the Montrose Golf Club, and reputed to be the 9th oldest golf club in the world.

In 1845 Prince Albert bestowed his Royal Patronage on the Club, and the name was changed to the Royal Albert Golf Club. In 1986 the Royal Albert merged with the Victoria Golf Club (founded in 1864) and the North Links Ladies Golf Club to form the Royal Montrose Golf Club. The Club is honoured to have HRH Prince Andrew, Duke of York, as our current patron.

Playing Golf

Club members play golf over the Montrose Links, which is home to the 18 hole 1562 Medal course and the shorter but still challenging 18 hole Broomfield course.

Membership

The Royal Montrose Golf Club welcomes Lady, Men, Student and Junior members. There is currently no waiting list for membership, and no entry fee.

It should be noted that Country, International, Associate and Junior Members have no voting rights within the Club.

Membership Classes

The following classes of membership are available: -

Ordinary: Adults over 25 years.

Intermediate: Adults over 18 years and under 25 years.

Student: Persons over age of 18 in full-time education.

Junior – 3: Young persons between 8 and 18 years

Junior – 2: Young persons between 6 and 8 years.

Junior – 1: Young persons under 6 years.

A limited number of equipment lockers are available to members at an annual rental.

Associate: This is a membership class for "Non-golfers" allowing access to social activities and the club Bars and Restaurant.

The following classes of membership are open to persons residing outside the area: -

Country: Adults 25 years and over living more than 20 miles from Montrose.

International: Adults over 25 years living outside the UK (see further details overleaf).

Information for International Members

1. This membership category is open to Men and Women.
2. This membership category is limited to 200 members at any one time.
3. Applicants must reside outside the United Kingdom.
4. Applications for membership must be proposed by the Captain, Secretary or Manager of the applicant's home Golf Club or equivalent Golfing facility.
5. International members have no voting rights.
6. International members will receive the following on joining the club: -
 - a. A Membership Card/Fixture List.
 - b. A copy of the Club Constitution.
 - c. A copy of the Royal Montrose 'Club History Book'.
 - d. All Club members are required to purchase a season ticket from, or pay a green fee to, Montrose Golf Links Ltd in order to play on either the 1562 Medal or Broomfield courses.

As part of the Membership package the Club will provide an International Member with 'One Four-ball tee time' out-with priority times on the Medal Course at a concessionary rate of 50% of normal green fees on the day in question. This facility to be processed through the Club Secretary.
